DRESS CODE HAIR CODE GUIDELINES

DRESS CODE Dancers must wear their uniform leotard, tights, and shoes for class. **Please see website for dress code details** and visit Arabesque Dancewear in Suite 303 for all uniform needs and to be fitted for shoes.

Do not wear dance shoes in the parking lot, as the oil damages our dance flooring.

HAIR must be pinned up into a tight bun for all classes. Loose hair distracts the dancer from learning. Students whose hair falls out will be required to sit out the remainder of class. Male dancers should keep hair trimmed appropriately to not obscure their vision or distract when dancing.

NO JEWELRY (other than small earrings) may be worn in class.

TARDINESS **Late students will not be admitted to class.** Arrive dressed and ready for class 5 minutes prior to class start time. Students arriving late disturb the entire class and miss important warm-up exercises. The class may be made up in an alternate class; if you arrive late, come to the office to find out your options.

ABSENCES Regular class attendance is vital to progress. Any classes missed must be made up in an alternate class. Please contact Miss Bridget to find out what classes are available to your student for make-ups. No refunds or credits are given when absences occur. All absences must be made up within the quarter missed. No make-up classes will be carried into the next quarter unless next quarter is paid in full.

OBSERVATION OF CLASSES Dance classes are closed to observers, except during designated observation weeks. Please see our Dates to Remember for observation week dates. You are encouraged to bring cameras and family members. Please do not bring small children and do not leave and re-enter the classroom during class.

FOOD & DRINKS Dancers must bring a water bottle to class. Only clear drinking water, no additives or flavoring, is allowed in classrooms. Nutritious snacks are encouraged. Please, no sweets or junk food, and no drinks in the school other than water and unsweetened iced tea.

TUITION A 10% late fee may be added to all late tuition payments. Students will not be permitted in class when tuition has reached two weeks delinquent.
