

Tucson Regional Ballet
Cleanliness and Safety Protocol
Revised July 30, 2020

-If you or a family member are sick, have had any signs of Covid-19 symptoms (cough, shortness of breathing, fever, chills, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell), or may have possibly been exposed, please stay home. We request that you also please stay home if you have traveled out of town or state on vacation or personal business. A 14-day self-quarantine from TRB is requested under circumstances of travel or exposure.

-Temperature checks will be conducted by Bridget prior to admittance to class. Please check your dancer's temperature at home before leaving for the studio. Dancers whose temperature is 100 degrees or higher may not take class. We encourage dancers who are staying home but feel well enough to dance to participate via Zoom.

-All dancers should only enter the studios through the back of the building. Bridget and teaching staff will direct traffic as the dancers end/begin each class. Please be mindful of our dancers' safety and be respectful towards our neighbors.

-All are required to bring and wear safety masks. Masks must be appropriately snug to the face and worn to cover both mouth and nose. Masks should be handled by the sides and hands washed or hand sanitizer used after handling; any removal of masks for water etc. must be done mindfully and appropriately distanced from fellow dancers. Teachers understand and will respect the need to breathe while dancing, and therefore, occasional breaks and modifications to class may be necessary. A few loaner masks may be available and must be returned to your instructor for laundering after exiting the studio.

-Front entrance & lobby will be closed for the time being.

-Dancers are highly encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer. Staff will sanitize barres after each use.

-All parents/guardians must only drop-off and pick-up. No congregating. We request that parents wear masks and maintain social distancing when interacting with other parents in the parking lot.

-Each studio will have tape marks for each dancer to be able practice physical distancing. Dancers must also follow all instructions from TRB staff regarding distancing. Unless otherwise instructed, dancers must stay 6 feet apart at all times, including entering/leaving studio, water breaks, and socializing.

-Dance bags should be separated and spread apart.

-We know we've missed each other, but air hugs only.

-One dancer at a time in the hallway to use the bathroom and must sanitize and wipe door knobs. Paper towels will be provided; please do not use air dryers. Please wash your hands thoroughly with soap for 20 seconds.

-Classes will also be broadcast via Zoom; please use mindfully. If you are attending via Zoom and have technical difficulties or the class has not been started for you, please call Bridget immediately at 886-1222 for troubleshooting assistance.

-If you have business in the office, please call Bridget to discuss an appointment. Any boutique purchases requiring fitting (shoes, leotards) will be by appointment only and require social distancing guidelines be met. Curbside service is available for boutique purchases not requiring fitting.

-Do not touch your eyes, nose, or mouth.

-After leaving the studio, wash hands, use hand sanitizer, and shower.

-Signs will be posted to help navigate the use of this Cleanliness and Safety Protocol.

-Missed classes may be made up via Zoom. If you wish to attend a live makeup, you must contact Bridget ahead of time to confirm space. No drop-ins allowed!
